

Maitland Levee – Horseshoe Bend Complete

The Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water have completed repair works as part of the Hunter Valley Flood Mitigation Scheme.

As part of the Hunter Valley Flood Mitigation Scheme, the Department have completed Stage 2 of the levee restoration at Horseshoe Bend.

The Hunter Valley Flood Mitigation Scheme is designed to mitigate flood risk as an integrated system operating across multiple local government areas, covering urban, peri-urban and rural areas.

Works are now complete on the levee, our work included excavation, rock and soil placement, laying of turf and installation of fencing along the effected levee area.
